



Registration & Admission Procedure:

- 1. The academic year begins in April and ends in March.
- 2. Registration is open for admission to the Nursery every year, admission age for Nursery is three years complete by 31 March 2025 i.e. born before 31 March 2022.
- 3. Admission to various classes shall be opened to all irrespective of class, creed or race. However the school authorities and the Principal reserve the right to refuse admission to a student who in their opinion is not or will not be able to cope with the syllabus.
- 4. Those who seek admission to classes other than Nursery will have to bring the school leaving certificate from the school last attended.
- 5. Birth certificate from the municipality duly attested should be produced at the time of admission.
- 6. Parents / guardians are asked to fill in the admission form with the utmost possible accuracy. No subsequent changes will be permitted thereafter whatsoever.
- 7. The admission procedure will be completed only after submitting the necessary documents and depositing due fees. Fee once deposited will not be refunded. Students can be withdrawn or removed from the school as under:

By school authorities on any one of the following grounds.

- i. Constant weakness in studies. ii. Irregularity in attendance.
- iii. Behavior problem. iv. Non-payment of fees.
- v. Disobedience of school rules and regulations.
- a. No school leaving certificate will be issued without written application from the parents / guardians only after the payment of all dues to the school.
- b. The Principal's decision shall be final in all cases of withdrawal or dismissal.
- c. A child who uses unfair means or receives or gives assistance in any form during tests will be given zero in the subject and repetition of the same fault will result in dismissal of the student

ADMISSION AND SCHOOL FEES

- 1. Only one time admission fee is charged.
- 2. Monthly fee has to be paid on or before 10th of every month, else a fine of rs 100 will be charged.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

- 1. A pupil will be eligible to appear in the final examinations only if he/she has a minimum of 80% attendance and if he/she has remitted the school fees of the entire year.
- 2. Criteria for promotion will be 40 % of marks in individual subjects on the basis of the marks/grades obtained in all examinations and the whole year's work of the pupil. The decision of the school authorities with regard to promotion is final.
- 3. No request for re-examination will be entertained nor shall the answer papers be shown to the students or to their parents.
- 4. Reports on a general progress and results of the term examinations are communicated to the parents by means of progress report.
